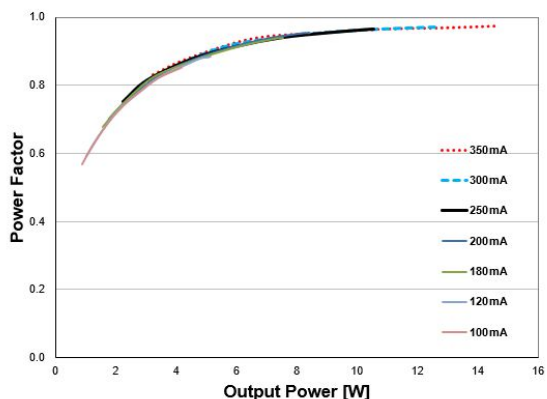

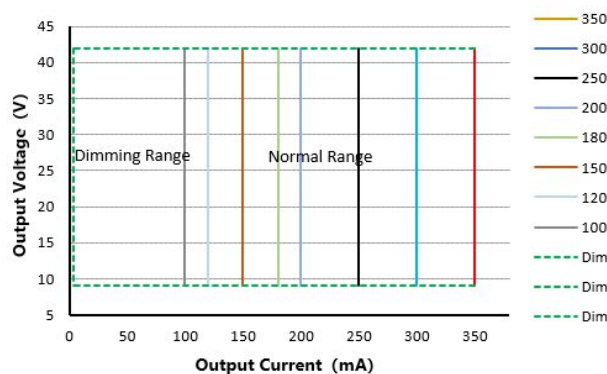

Typical Power Factor v Load

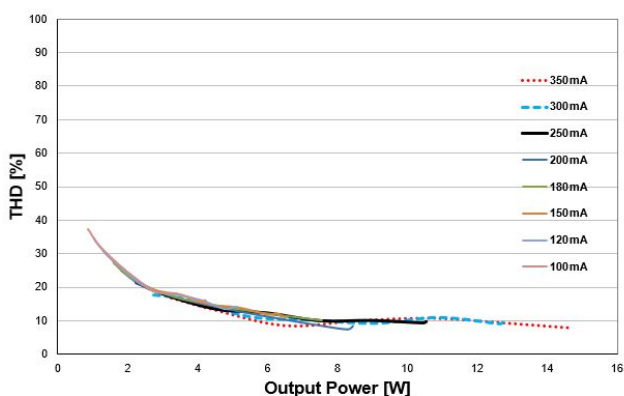

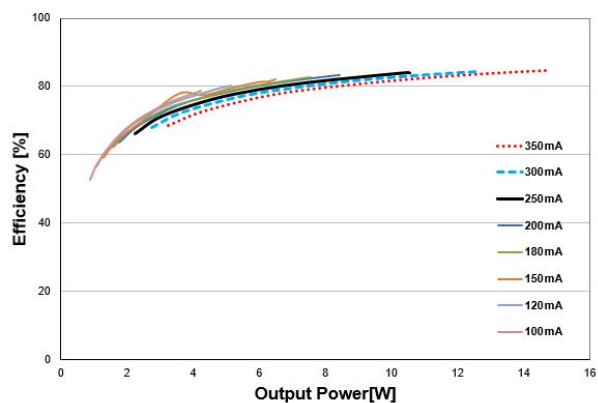
Typical Power Factor vs load of IT DALI 15

Typical Operating Window of IT DALI 15

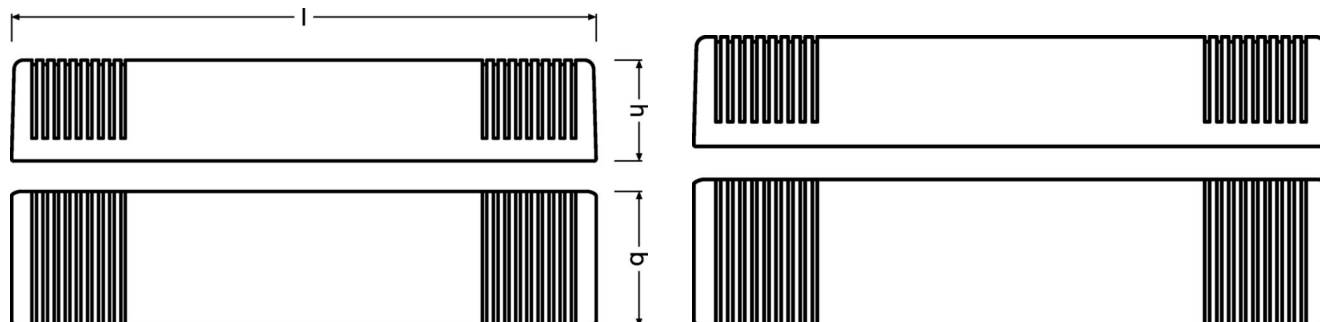
Typical Efficiency v Load 230 V 50 Hz

Intended for use with LED modules.

The forward voltage of the LED light source shall be within the defined operating window of the control gear in all operating conditions including dimming if applicable.

Separate control gear and light sources must be disposed of at certified disposal companies in accordance with Directive 2012/19/EU (WEEE) in the EU and with Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Regulations 2013 in the UK. For this purpose, collection points for recycling centres and take-back systems (CRSO) are available from retailers or private disposal companies, which accept separate control gear and light sources free of charge. This OSRAM driver can be configured using the Tuner4TRONIC software. This requires registering on www.myosram.com and downloading the Tuner4TRONIC software from the Internet. A password key (Config Lock) must be set up in the driver via the Tuner4TRONIC software in order to control which users can access and view operational data.
